TOOLS:

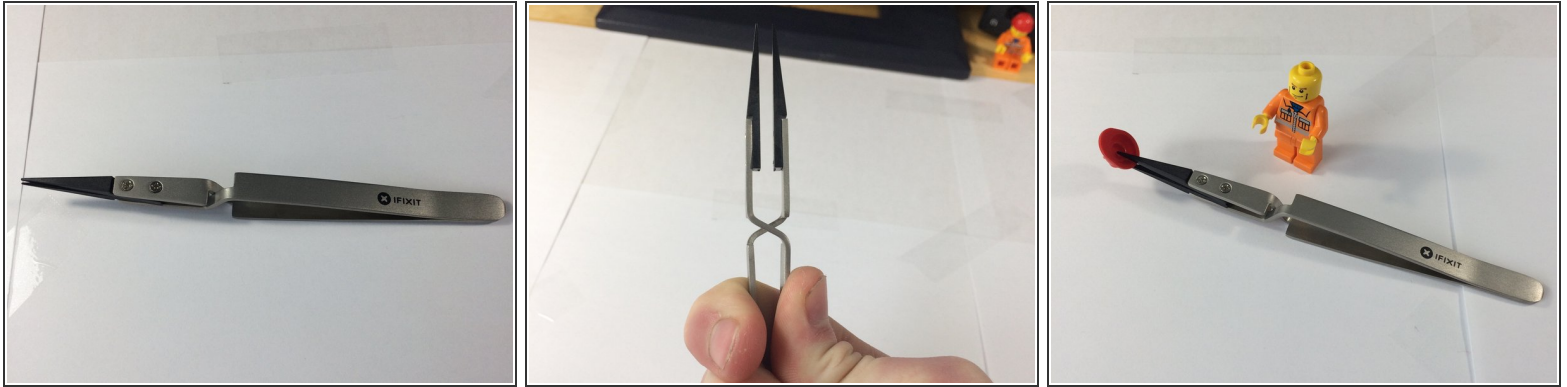
- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)



PARTS:

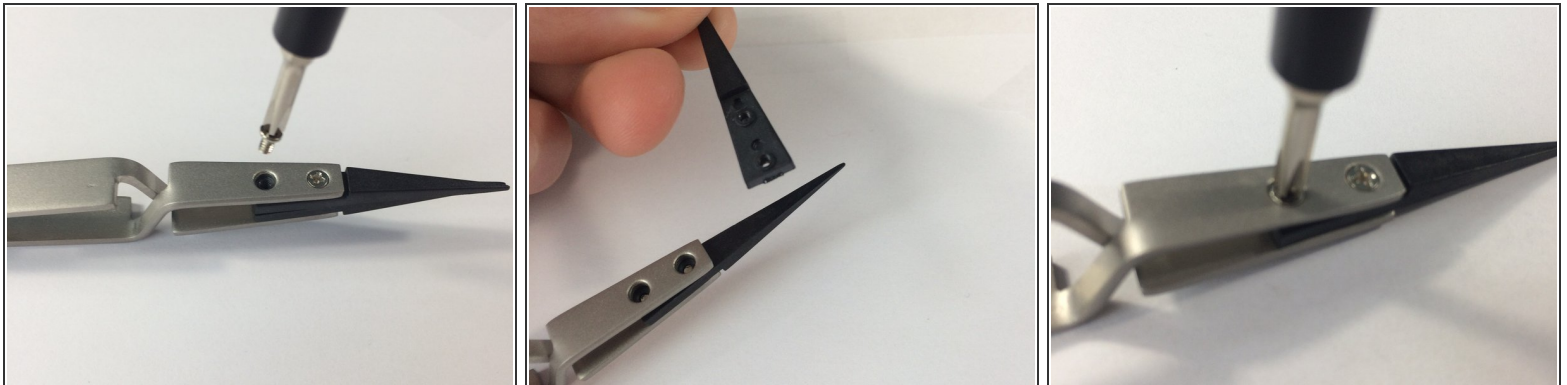
- [Nylon Tipped Tweezers](#) (1)

Step 1 — Reversed tweezers Teardown



- This my friends, is the first ever iFixit-made-tool teardown on iFixit
- Stainless steel body and nylon tips, with the iFixit logo printed on it...
- Reversed so you can hold tiny Lego hats even when your hands are busy...

- So far we've been able to take off a lot of the tool's construction using *Only a PH0 screwdriver!*
