



How to Clean the Fan on a Toshiba TDP-XP2

This guide shows how to the clean the fans on a Toshiba projector to help with over-heating issues.

INTRODUCTION

Fans on electronic devices collect a lot dust over the years, so this guide will show how to clean the fan on this Toshiba projector in order to prevent overheating. To ensure maximum performance out of a fan, some oil can be added to keep the bearings lubricated and running in tip-top shape.

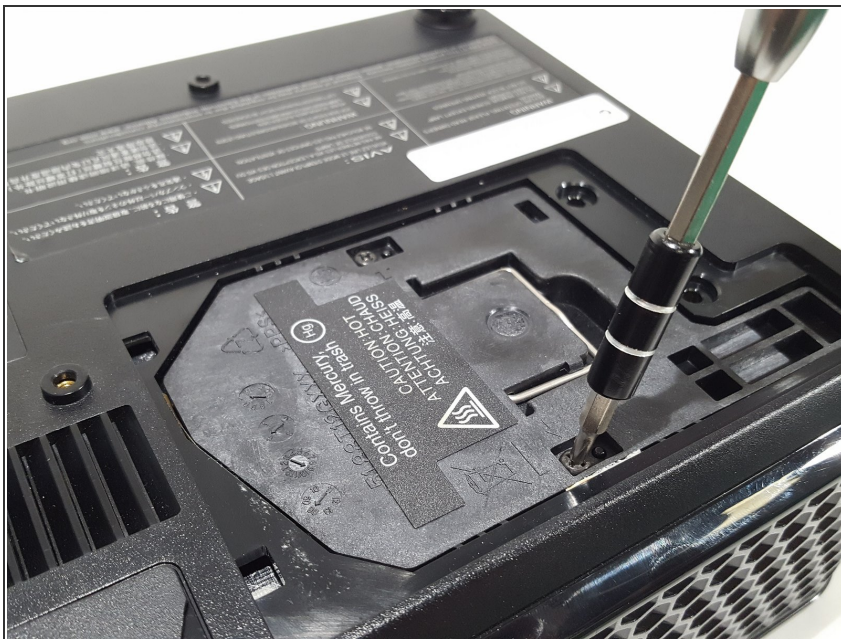

Step 1 — How to Clean the Fan on a Toshiba TDP-XP2



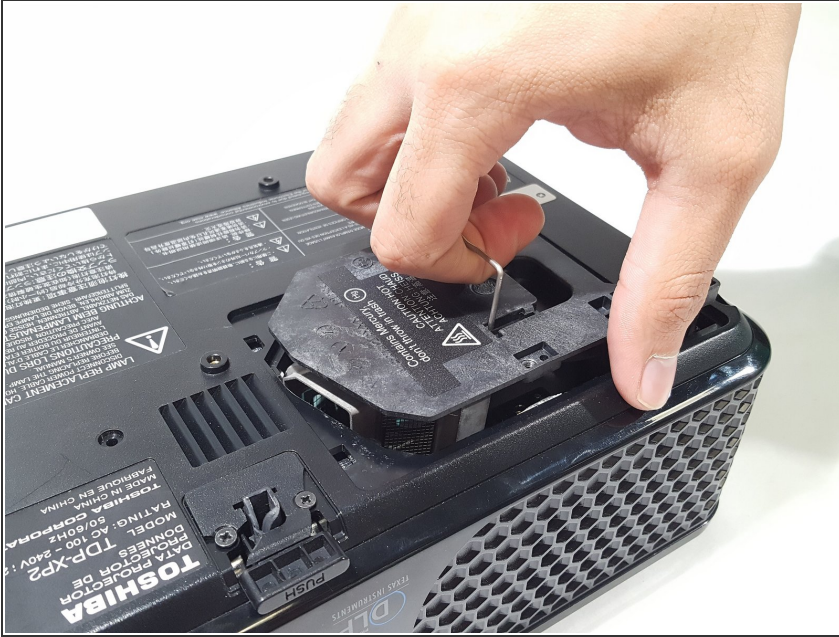
- Remove the two screws from the bottom plate as shown.

Step 2



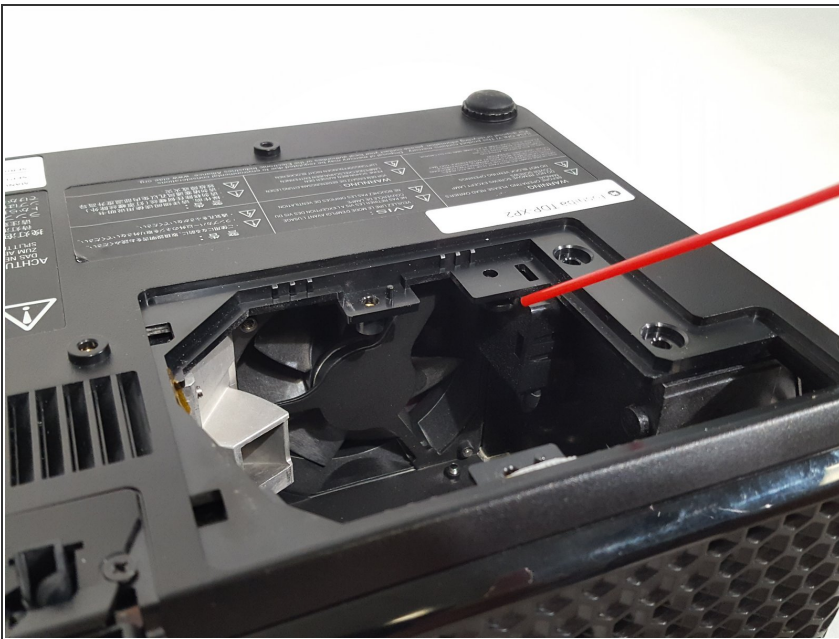
- Remove the two screws on the bulb housing.

Step 3



- Pull the tab up and pull the bulb out vertically. Some force will be required, but it will come out.

Step 4



- Using a can of compressed air, blow on the fan until all dust is gone.
- Oil can be added in with a dropper on the bearing if needed.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
