


# Dell Inspiron M5010 Display Assembly Replacement

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# **INTRODUCTION**


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Display Assembly.



# **TOOLS:**

• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Remove the Screws




- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in Before You Begin.
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- Turn the computer over and remove the two screws.

### **Step 2** — **Disconnect the Cables**




 Disconnect the Mini-Card antenna cables from the Mini-Card.

## Step 3 — Disconnect the Display Cable



 Disconnect the display cable from the connector on the system board and remove it from the routing guide.

#### Step 4 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the four screws (two on each side) that secure the display assembly to the computer base.

# Step 5 — Lifting the Display Assembly



 Lift and remove the display assembly out of the computer base.

#### Step 6 — Placing the Display Assembly




 Place the **NEW** display assembly in position and replace the four screws (two on each side) that secure the display assembly to the computer base.

#### **Step 7** — Route the Display Cable




 Route the display cable into the routing guide and connect the cable to the connector on the system board.

## **Step 8 — Connecting the Mini-Card Antenna Cables**



 Connect the Mini-Card antenna cables to the connectors on the Mini- Card.

#### Step 9 — Replace the Screws



 Turn the computer over and replace the two screws at the bottom of the computer.
