


Lenovo Ideapad 320-15IAP Battery Replacement

How to replace the battery of a Lenovo Ideapad 320-15IAP

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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this guide is to demonstrate how to replace the battery of your Lenovo Ideapad 350-15IAP. This replacement guide is very simple and requires very little technical knowledge to complete. In summary, you will be using a Phillip's head screwdriver to remove the case of the laptop. The battery will be immediately exposed and can be removed by simply removing four screws.



TOOLS:

- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tool (1)



PARTS:

- Lenovo IdeaPad 320-14, 520-15, V320-17 Replacement Battery (1)
- Lenovo IdeaPad 320-14, 520-15, V320-17 Battery - Genuine (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- (i) Before you begin, be sure to turn off your laptop and unplug it from the outlet.
- Using a Phillips #0 screwdriver, unscrew all thirteen 6.5 mm screws from the back case.

Step 2




- Pull the CD drive outwards with an opening tool until it pops out as shown. It is possible you have to apply a substantial amount of force so watch your fingers while doing so.
- Remove the CD drive.

Step 3



 Lift up the cover using the opening tool on different spots along the side of the laptop.


Step 4





Using a Phillips #0 screwdriver to unscrew the four 5.5 mm screws securing the battery.


Step 5





Disconnect the battery cable from its motherboard socket by gently pulling it towards the battery.
Pull parallel to the battery, not straight up.

Step 6



Remove the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

For optimal performance, after completing this guide, <u>calibrate</u> your newly installed battery.

Take your e-waste to an R2 or e-Stewards certified recycler.
