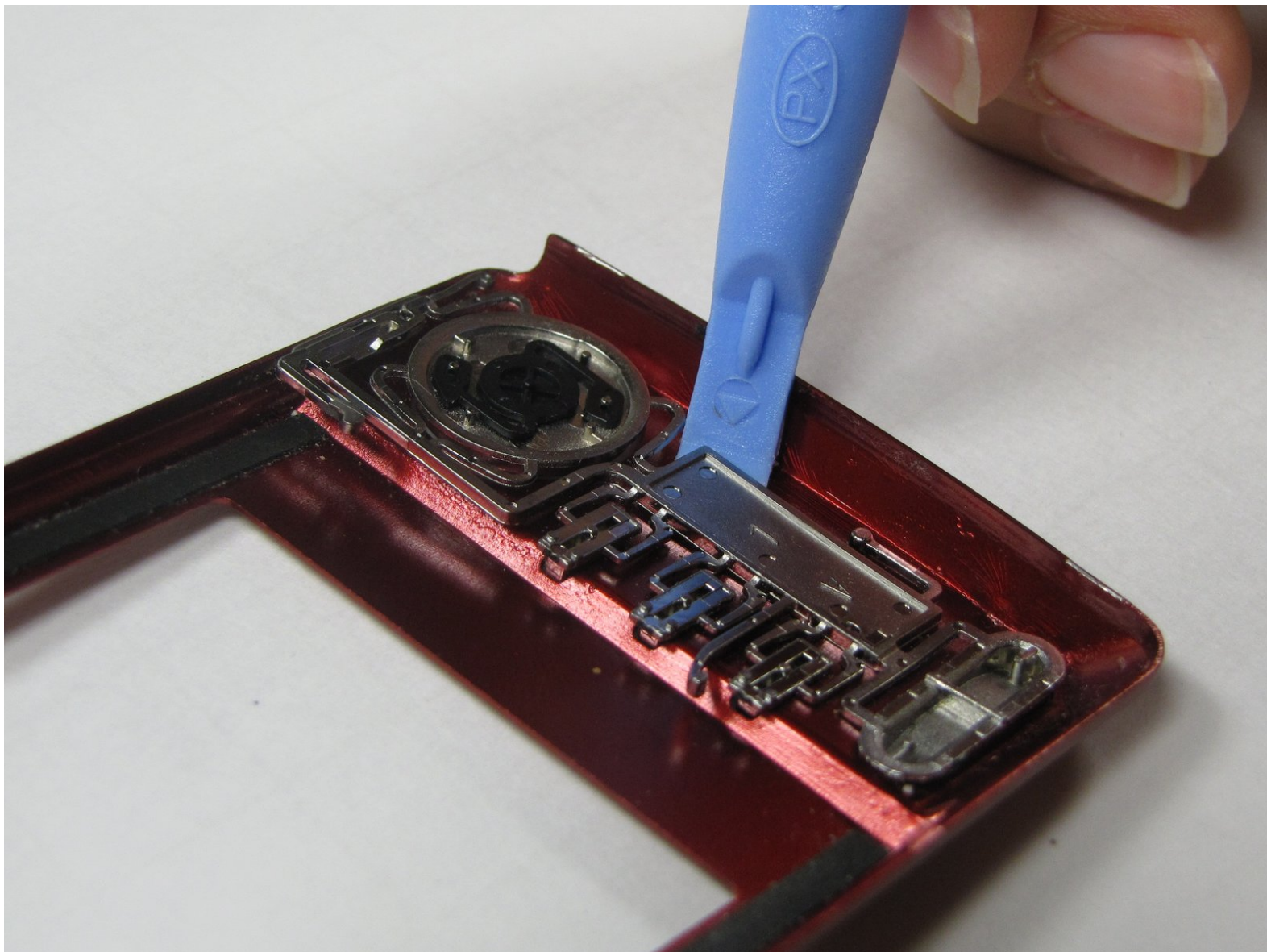




# Replacing Sanyo VPC-X1200 Rear Buttons

# INTRODUCTION

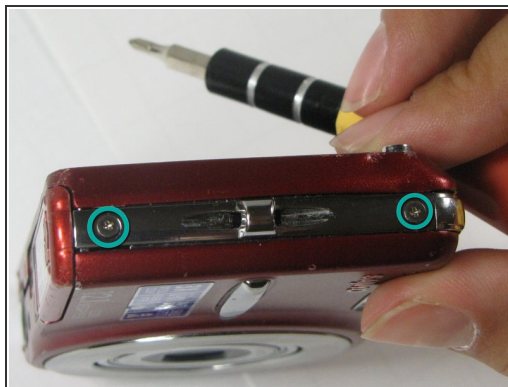
This is an easy guide to replacing the rear buttons on the Sanyo VPC-X1200.



## TOOLS:

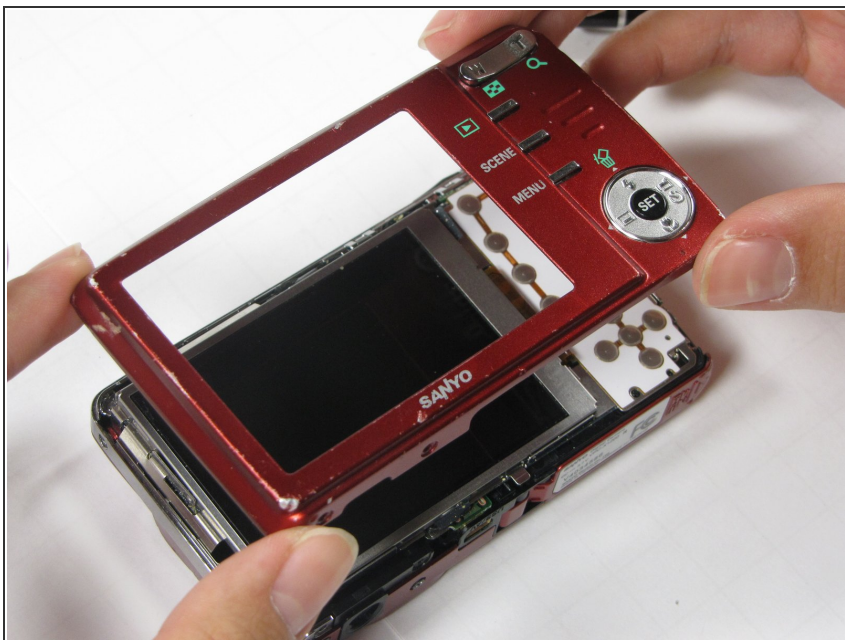
- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Back Case



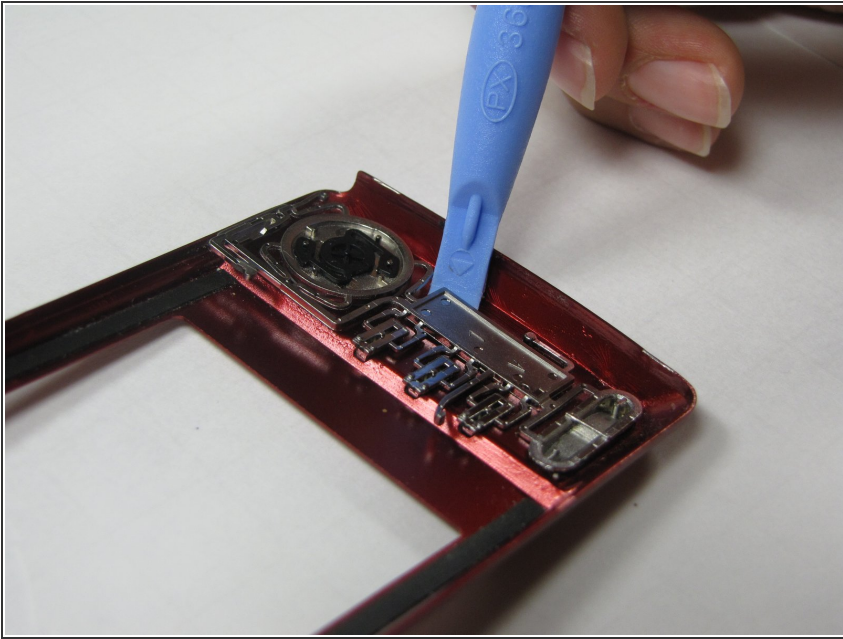
- Remove the five case screws with a Phillips #00 Screwdriver.
- Five 3.5mm Phillips Screws

## Step 2



- Gently lift up the back cover and set aside.

### Step 3 — Rear Buttons



- Use small plastic pry tool to gently remove rear button plate.
- A heat gun may be used to soften the glue for easier removal.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
