

Motorola Moto G 1st Generation Speaker Replacement

Replace your back speaker when it goes bad.

INTRODUCTION

This guide shows you how to replace the speaker on a Motorola Moto G 1st Generation smartphone.

TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

Step 1 — Rear Panel



(i) Before you start following any of the steps of this guide, completely turn the device off.

• Take the plastic back cover off by either using a plastic Pry tool or simply using your hands. Start from the bottom by the charging port

Step 2 — Removing the Screws



 Unscrew the 3.5mm screws, total of 14, located on the back protective cover by using a T5 Torx screwdriver.

Step 3 — Removing the Battery Cover



- Use a plastic opening tool to remove the protective cover.
- A Carefully work the plastic tool around all the edges of the phone.
- (i) The protective cover holds the Volume and the Home buttons which might fall off the assembly when the cover is removed.

Step 4 — Removing the Speaker



Use the plastic opening tool to remove the Speaker from the protective cover.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
