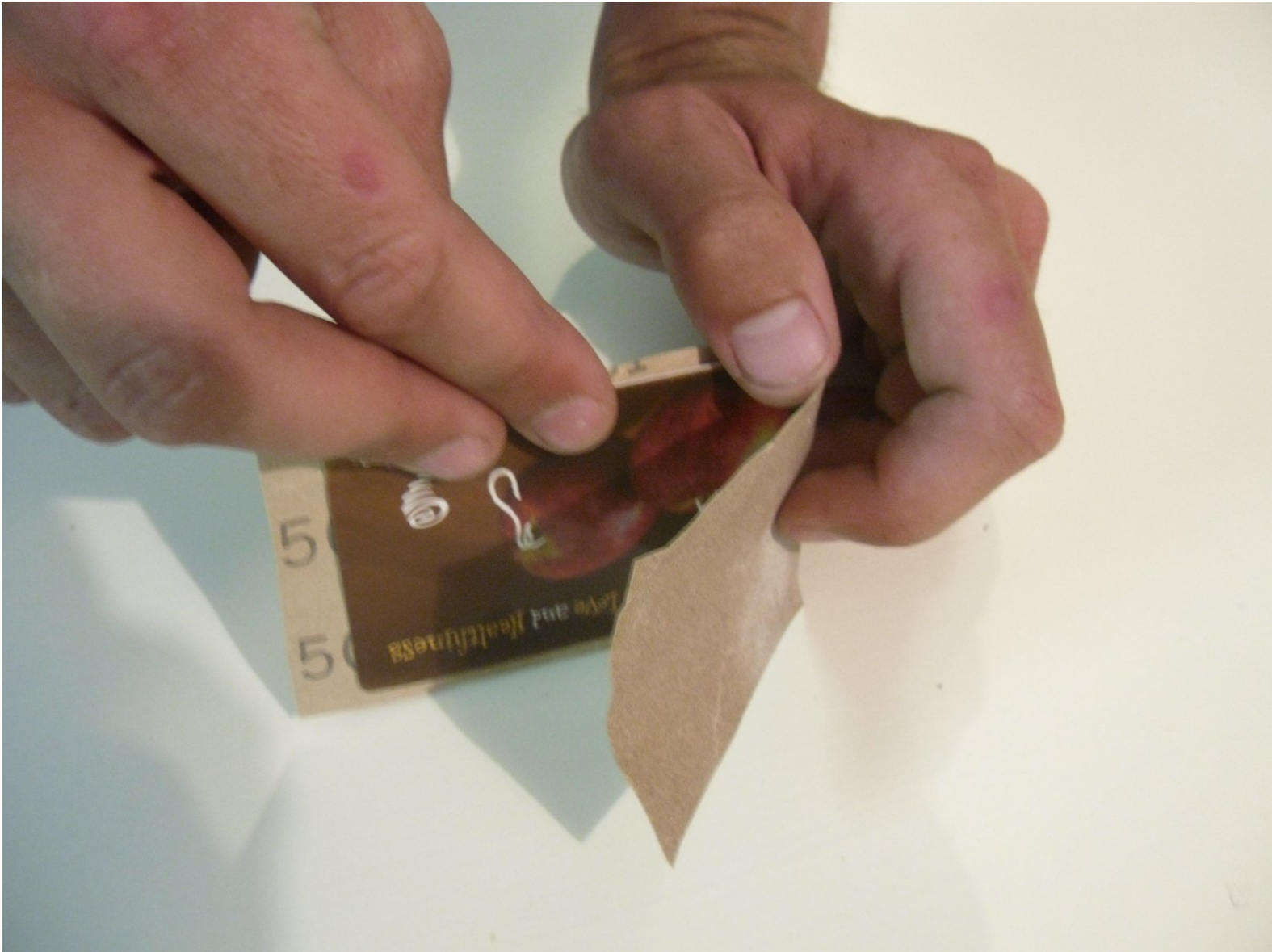




How to clean the Sega Genesis game port

This guide will show you how to clean the game port on the Sega Genesis.

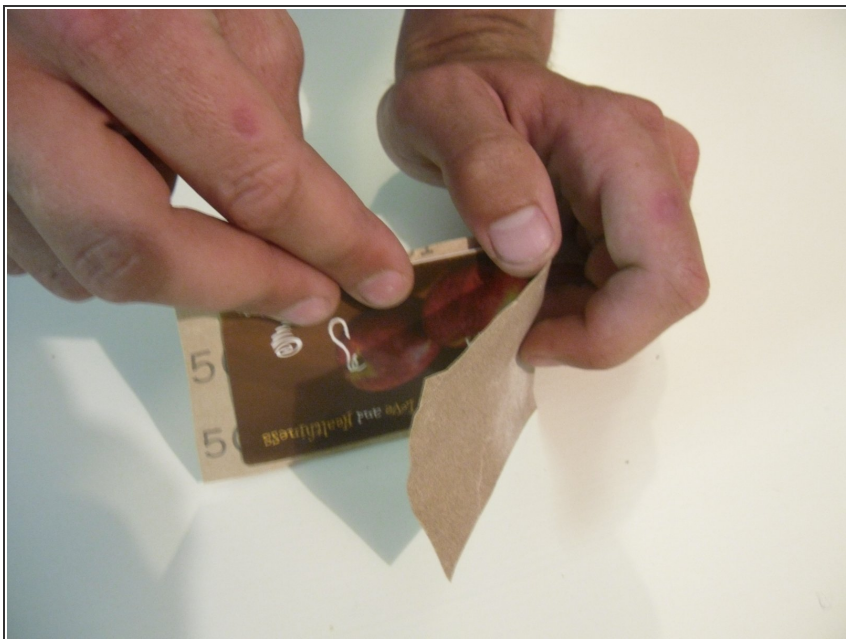

Step 1 — How to clean the Sega Genesis game port



- Fold fine grit sand paper over a credit card.

Step 2



- Rub credit card with sand paper up and down vertically inside the game cartridge port.

Step 3



- Blow out game cartridge port using a can of compressed air.

⚠ Warning: Do not turn the aerosol can upside down as you spray.

Step 4



- Rub a Q-tip dipped in rubbing alcohol along the pins of the cartridge slot to remove any remaining debris.
