#### **INTRODUCTION**


Make sure your computer is off and battery is out before attempting to replace your wireless adaptor.



## **TOOLS:**

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Battery



- Turn off your computer! Taking out the battery while it's still on is dangerous!
  - Flip the laptop over to the back.
- Using two hands, push on the tabs while gently taking out the battery.

#### Step 2 — Wireless Card

- Make sure the computer is off.
- Using a Phillips #1, unscrew the 5mm screw on the bottom of the laptop
- Remove the back cover plate.
  - (i) The cover has popping tabs so it might require a small amount of force to remove.

## Step 3





- Using a blue plastic prying tool, gently pry off the 2 connectors.
- The black cable goes on the connection closer to where the cables originate, while the white cable goes on the farther connection.

## Step 4





- Using the Phillips #1 screwdriver, unscrew the 2 3mm screws.
  - (i) Adaptor is spring-loaded.
- You can now take out the adaptor.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
