


# Cuisinart DLC-10S Pro Classic 7-Cup Food Processor Power Cord Replacement

## Step 1 — Power Cord




 Use a screwdriver to remove the four screws that are next to the grip pads on the bottom of the motor base.

# Step 2




• Remove the black plastic covering from the motor base.

## Step 3




• Locate the connections between the power cord and the brown and white wires. Cut off these connections.

# Step 4




• Strip the plastic coating off the edge of the brown and white wires using a wire stripper.

## Step 5



 Create a connection between the brown and white wires and the wires of the new power cord by <u>soldering</u> them together.

#### Step 6



 Fit the wires back into the motor base and place the new power cord in the slot.

By the end of this guide< you will have successfully replaced the power cord to your device.
