


LG G4 Front Camera Replacement

If the front camera on your LG G4 is not working properly, this guide will show you how to replace it.




- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)



LG G4 Front Camera (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover



- Remove the rear cover by placing the plastic opening tool in the groove on the bottom left side of the LG G4 and gently prying up.


Step 2





 Place the plastic opening tool at the bottom edge of the battery and lift up. Carefully remove battery with your hands.

Step 3








• Remove the **eleven** 3.9 mm Phillips #00 screws found at the back of the phone.

Step 4








- Once all the screws have been removed, place the plastic opening tool in the lower left corner and firmly lift the cover up.
- Detach the cover with your fingers

Step 5 — Front Camera







- Detach the Front Camera ribbon cable located on the top right corner of the back of the phone by gently lifting it up with a plastic opening tool. Remove the front camera.
- ⚠ Be careful when removing the cables and pulling out the front camera to avoid tearing the attached cable.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
