#### **INTRODUCTION**

WIFI not working or slow? Replace it (only screwdrivers required).



T4 Torx Screwdriver (1) Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1) iFixit Opening Tool (1)

#### Step 1 — Wireless Card



• Remove ten 3mm screws from the back cover with a T5 screwdriver.

## Step 2



• Remove the black tape covering the RAM and wireless card with your hands.

#### Step 3



• Use a plastic iFixit opening tool to remove the two wires connected to the wireless card.

## Step 4



• Use a **PH00** screwdriver to remove the one 3mm screw that holds the wireless card in place.

## Step 5



• Use your hand to remove the wireless card.
